Information to be provided on the demographics which are less likely to recycle.		In 2017 Moray Council commissioned a waste compositional analysis to be undertaken. This analysis forms the most up-to-date data available with regards recycling performance and demographics within Moray.  The analysis focused on understanding the contents of the residual waste stream only, and did not involve analysis of the recycling waste streams. The data showed that the most deprived group (OAC 8- Hard-Pressed Living) produced the most waste and that their residual waste contained the most food waste (37.3%). The data suggested that OAC 5 (Urbanites) had the lowest proportion of recyclables within their kerbside residual waste stream.
