The revised submission sought funding for up to 50 on-street chargers, the locations of which will be determined through consultation with Housing and Property Services colleagues (as many properties without off-street parking are in council housing areas) and local communities. Since we have joined the Pathfinder project the award of the Moray grant will be as part of that joint submission to Transport Scotland.
