Information Sought:	Response:
Councillor Warren sought clarification on how long lorries have been unable to access the weighbridge at Buckie Harbour, the loss of income to the Council and would there be any compensation to the Harbour for the delays. In response the Head of Environmental and Commercial Services confirmed that the weighbridge replacement was completed earlier in the new year and there have been some issues along with resolving the issues with the testing have meant some delays, however an update would be provided to Committee in the future. She further added that even with the issues indicated, income for Harbours is up on previous years.	Since being relocated as part of the works to accommodate the Ocean Winds development at Buckie Harbour, the weighbridge has not operated since January 2023. Work to calibrate and verify the weighbridge was completed in August 2023 but since then roadworks required to support the upgrade of electrical capacity have closed off the access to the weighbridge. When these works are completed a notice will be issued to haulier to advise them that the weighbridge is operational again.
