Deaths involving coronavirus (COVID-19) up to 28th June

As of 28th June, 20 Moray residents had a death registered which mentioned COVID-19.

The first mention of COVID-19 in a death registration in Scotland was in the week beginning 16th March 2020.

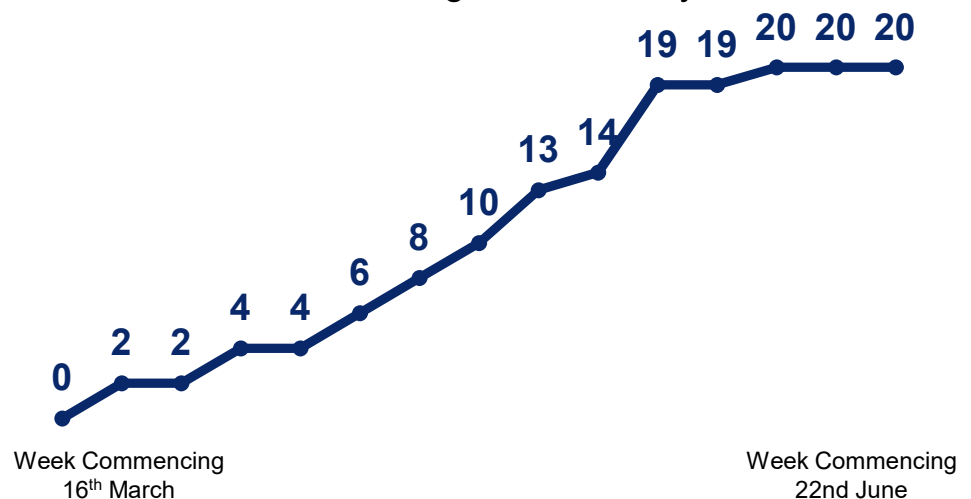
In the week beginning 22nd June, 0% of all deaths in Moray were COVID-19 related.

This is down from 0% in the previous week.

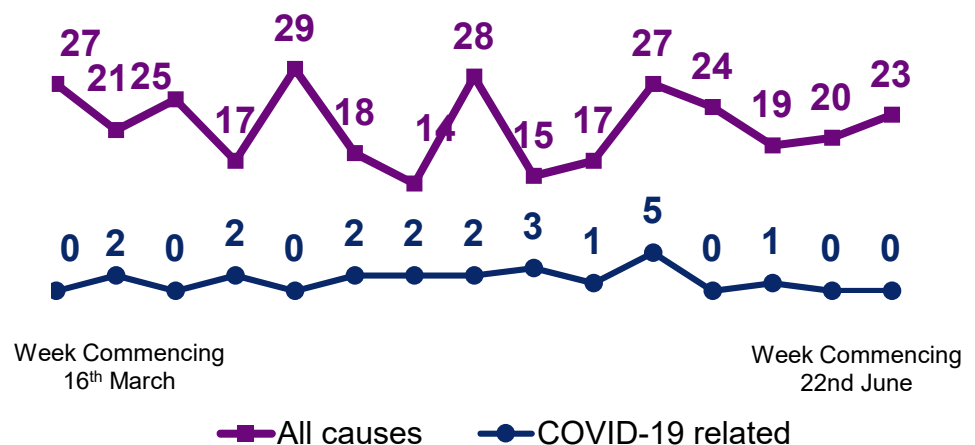
Deaths vary by location.

60% of deaths have occurred in Hospital, 30% have occurred in Home / Non-institution and a further 10% have occurred within the Care Home.

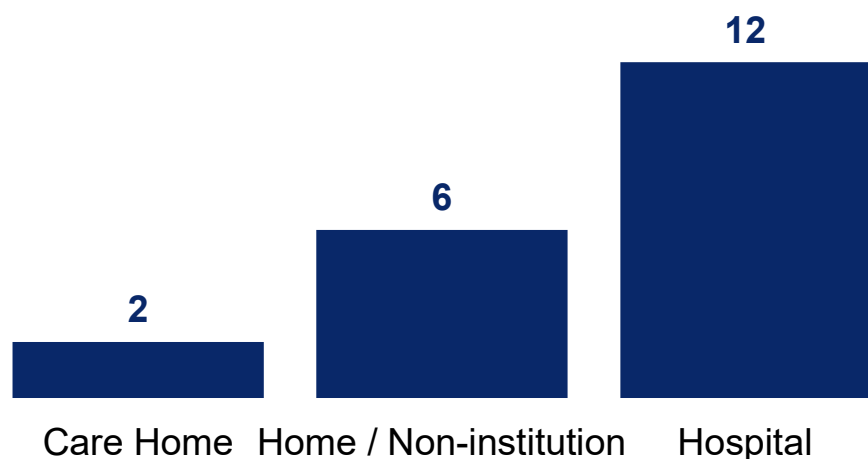
Cumulative deaths involving COVID-19 by week



Total deaths and deaths involving COVID-19 by week



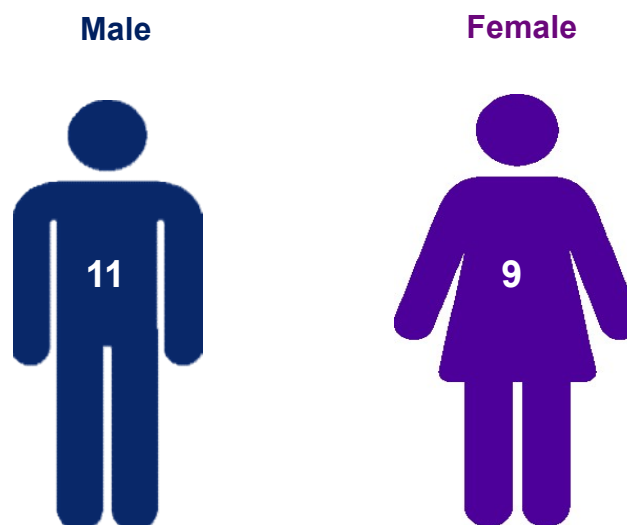
Number of deaths involving COVID-19 by location of death, up to 28th June 2020.



As of 28th June, the gender split of Moray registered deaths which mentioned COVID-19 was 55% male and 45% female.

For comparison, the Scotland gender split of deaths which mentioned COVID-19 was 50% male and 50% female.

The highest number of deaths have occurred in the 75-84 and 85+ age groups.

Deaths in these age groups accounted for 78% of female deaths and 64% of male deaths.
