One potential source of confusion when assessing the condition rating is the distinction between condition and suitability.	
		Compliance with the design intent should be addressed under condition. Hence, condition deals with the state of repair of features or facilities that exist as part of the fabric (and as part of its current design).	
		Suitability rating does not include any issues which should be considered under condition,	

the facilities should be assessed as through they were in a good condition.
For example, a leaking roof, however inconvenient, should not affect the suitability rating but should instead be a matter to be considered in the context of the condition rating.

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
