Strategic Transportation Services Manager to advise whether the pipeline at St Peters Road, Buckie is being extended from one end to the other and what the timeline for this is.	<p>We are not looking at any improvement to the double mini roundabouts at St Peters Road in Buckie.</p> <p>The improved pedestrian islands have assisted those seeking to cross the road. Capacity analysis has been undertaken as part of Transport Assessments to accompany planning applications and they identified that there was ample capacity at the junctions.</p> <p>There are known issues at the location associated with school drop off/pick up times and the appropriate, proportionate response to these issues is for education programmes such as Park Smart to take place.</p>
