Confirmation to be sought and the information updated if required, regarding using play equipment in school playgrounds after hours.	<p>Site assessments for the Play Sufficiency Assessments were undertaken during the school holidays and officers found that some play equipment within school grounds was not accessible. These play areas have not been included within the Play Sufficiency Assessment. The “open playground policy” is being discussed with Education.</p> <p>The Play Sufficiency Assessment mapping includes play areas within different ownership across Moray. It is proposed to work with Open Spaces and GIS to create a map that will be used internally showing the Council owned/managed play spaces. The intention is that this would include all play equipment that is owned/managed by Moray Council including those within school grounds. This mapping would be separate from the PSA.</p>
