This will be reported back to Committee in due course.</p> <p>The signage at Gollachy and Waterford Household Waste and Recycling Centres has recently been updated. A review of the remaining sites is planned but this will be expedited with any clear and obvious issues receiving upgrades ahead to the full review being undertaken.</p> <p>Requests have been made for the Aberlour Recycling point to be monitored and increased emptying put in place if this is deemed necessary.</p> <p>The works are proposed to be undertaken this year. Design work is awaiting resources to be freed up.</p>
