

Motion for Full Council - 23/01/2019

That council notes with concern the proposed reductions in local government core funding detailed in the draft Scottish Government budget 2019/20 and recognises that without significant additional investment vital local services will be put under unprecedented strain.

The council leader is therefore requested to write an open letter to the finance minister Derek McKay MSP stating that Moray council objects in the strongest possible terms to this latest real terms cut in its core funding, and reiterates to the minister the devastating impact this settlement will have on communities across Moray if additional money is not forthcoming from the Scottish Government.
