Para 4.15 Partnership Programme – what is the impact on lack of participation (transitions for p7s)		School partners had opted for support around Health and Wellbeing priorities with 21 young people taking part in Elgin, 26 in Lossiemouth and two in Forres (35 sessions in all) Pupils also took part in sessions around youth facilities involving 81 young people in Buckie and 62 in Forres. Since then all new staff have been through their Professional Development Award in Youth Work and are confidently using national Youth Work Outcomes to frame their interventions with senior phase pupils to enhance their employability options. Seven of the eight secondary schools are currently offering this option (previously had been three) alongside continued health and wellbeing support.
