As such any sales prior to this time should be considered, as per the boards policy, in line with tourism related activities and not just vertical drinking. As the request of on sales hours does not extend beyond 0100, the premises would not be considered late opening and I have no adverse comment to make in this regard.</p> <p>In respect of point 5, as per the boards policy, any outdoor drinking areas must cease operation by 2200 hours and are thereafter cleared away by 2230 hours.</p>
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				<p>In respect of point 6, regarding the fulfilment of remote orders by click and collect, a recorded age verification system should be in place in respect of any remote/online sale of alcohol and at the point of collection.</p> <p>In respect of point 10 and the wording “young persons will be allowed access at all times”, this is to be removed and young persons are to be subjected to the same access as children, until 2200 hours or until the end of a pre-booked function.</p> <p>Applicant not confirmed acceptance of conditions</p> <p>Waiting for paperwork No objections Site visit 3<sup>rd</sup> February 2023</p>
