

## Moray Health and Social Care Partnership - Excess Mortality


For the total period (week ending 29th March to 21st June), Moray HSCP had 35 (15%) more deaths than the previous 5 year average. Excess Deaths varied across age group and gender:



For the most recent week ending 21st June, Moray had **0 (2%)** deaths less than average:



• The largest percentage increase in deaths for the HSCP was seen in the week ending 19th April with 77% more deaths than the previous 5 year average. ■ For Scotland, the week with the highest percentage increase was week ending 12th April (80%)
